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



#### SCENE 1


SETTING:

Take Scene AT RISE:

CINDERELLA is walking about the yard obliviously immersed in a book she is reading. She wears simple clothes, sneakers and wears thick glasses. She sings to herself as she reads.


PRINCE FREDDY is wandering by. He is also dressed in simple clothes (rather than princely garments), wears very thick glasses and is also deeply immersed in a book.

A quiet, magical woman, GWENDOLYN THE WELL WISHER, hovers in the background. Using her hands she magically waves CINDERELLA and PRINCE FREDDY together and snickers to herself.


CINDERELLA and PRINCE FREDDY bump into each other. As they do so, they both lose their glasses, which fall to the ground.

PRINCE FREDDY No, my fault! **CINDERELLA** My glasses! PRINCE FREDDY Where'd they go? (They are bothnearly sightless without their glasses and they fumble around trying to find them.) CINDERELLA Sorry, guess I was lost in my book . . . PRINCE FREDDY Yeah. Me too. **CINDERELLA** I had just stumbled upon this absolutely amazing quotation and my mind just froze up or something. PRINCE FREDDY Oh. What was it? **CINDERELLA** Well, it was just this dry philosophical treatise from the age of enlightenment-PRINCE FREDDY Really? I love philosophy. **CINDERELLA** Oh, well, it goes: "The essence of true beauty lies . . . " (By this time they have each picked up the wrong pair of glasses and put them on. They stare at each other and can see perfectly.) **FREDDY** "... Beyond what's seen by normal eyes." (They smile at each other.) CINDERELLA Yeah. You've read it too.

Included among them are a SPIDER, a CROW and a TOAD. Now that she is alone, they move closer to her.) 

Stand back, everyone. My beauty is so bright I'm like a total ellipse of the sun.



5 GWENDOLYN

Magic is fun. For a short while. But magic won't change you. And it won't change the world, Cinderella. Only you can do that.

I see.

5 GWENDOLYN

Trust yourself, Cinderella.

1 CINDERELLA

I will.

5 GWENDOLYN

Midnight then. Don't forget.

Midnight. Got it. No problem.



PRINCE FREDDY is standing in stubborn consternation, trying to read a book KING FREDERICK and GASTON are pacing back and forth trying to talk to him.

1 PRINCE FREDDY

I told you I'm not going.

2 KING FREDERICK

Not going? Not going? You've got to be kidding me!

3 GASTON

I tried reasoning with the stubborn garcon, your highness.

2 KING FREDERICK

Do you know what the caterer's costing me? Go down and take a look at the spread I'm paying for. There's twelve different kinds of cheese on that buffet. Count 'em! Now you're going downstairs to that ball and you're going to have fun whether you enjoy yourself or not!

1 PRINCE FREDDY

I need to catch up on some philosophy. I'd prefer to read tonight.

2 KING FREDERICK

Read? You've got all day tomorrow to read. You've got the rest of your life to read. You're a prince! It's a government job. It's not like you have to work.

3 GASTON

Prince Freddy, think of all the women down there. The women, monsieur. Women. Huh?

#### PRINCE FREDDY Why? They all just want my money. 2 KING FREDERICK Which puts you in the enviable spot to choose whatever babe you want. It's like shooting fish in a barrel down there. Now get down to that ball and pick out a bride! PRINCE FREDDY That's really kind of shallow, isn't it? 2 KING FREDERICK (To GASTON) He's not my son. Tell me he's not my son! **GASTON** Freddy, we understand your apprehension. You are inexperienced with the ways of women, no? Trust us. We will show you how to entice and flatter a woman.

KING FREDERICK You're a prince. You say, "O.K., you." Then you get married.



Dad . . .

KING FREDERICK

O.K. You ought to ask her first. It's just a formality, but they like that.

GASTON

I understand you, Freddy. You want a more subtle approach. You want to woo her. Wooooo her.

PRINCE FREDDY

Woo?

3 GASTON

It is an art! A lost art, I'm afraid.

PRINCE FREDDY

I don't know how to woo.

GASTON

Ahh, we must teach you then. First-

KING FREDERICK First, it doesn't hurt that you're a prince. GASTON Please, your highness-KING FREDERICK Well, it doesn't. I'm just being honest. (GASTON puts his arm around the PRINCE.) GASTON First, monsieur, you must make the lady feel that she's the most special woman alive in the world. PRINCE FREDDY

O.K. . . .

3 GASTON

Then, let her know that you cannot possibly exist on this earth without the gift of her company.

KING FREDERICK

Then remind her that you're a prince.

(GASTON glares at the KING, then continues.)

3 GASTON

Then, ask her if she'd give you the honor of making you the happiest of men—by allowing you to tend to her happiness for the rest of your days.

KING FREDERICK

And if not, does she have any sisters?

3 GASTON

Your highness!

KING FREDERICK

I'm being practical here.


(PRISCILLA and CLARISSA grab CINDERELLA.)





(PRISCILLA grabs the slipper from GASTON.)

5 PRISCILLA

My slipper as you can see, is expensive and stylish, just like me. I suppose you'd like to try it on me, wouldn't you?



If you're the owner.

(She sits on a stool, kicks off her shoe and holds up her bare foot to PRINCE FREDDY.)

5 PRISCILLA

THAT'S MY SLIPPER!
MY ROYAL FOOT FITS IN IT
MY ROYAL LIFE'S BEGINNING
IT'S MY DESTINY

JUST LIKE SPAGHETTI

(PRINCE FREDDY slides the slipper onto her foot.)

I'm sorry. But it is not a fit, for me. You're not the one either. **BRUNHILDA** Great! (BRUNHILDA quickly darts into the house.) PRISCILLA But-that can't be! No fair! PRINCE FREDDY I'm sorry to bother you folks. GASTON Let's go home. PRINCE FREDDY I guess she's not here, Gaston. GASTON I'm sorry, monsieur. PRINCE FREDDY (To the STEPSISTERS) Good day. (BRUNHILDA lifts up her dress a bit to reveal that she is wearing Cinderella's other sneaker.)

She's a fair, young widow . . . with much romance left inside her, Freddy. Try it on, baby. Nice and slow.

2 PRINCE FREDDY

(Unenthusiastically)
Are you sure you're the girl I met—

(BRUNHILDA grabs the sneaker and puts it on herself.)

3 BRUNHILDA

THAT'S MY SNEAKER!
MY ROYAL FOOT FITS IN IT
MY ROYAL LIFE'S BEGINNING
IT'S MY DESTINY
YOU GET THE REST OF ME
THANK YOU, FREDDY
I'M STRONG AND STEADY
I'M PRIMED AND READY
TAKE YOUR BRIDE.

2 PRINCE FREDDY

Wait-wait-

(BRUNHILDA grabs his arm.)

3 BRUNHILDA

When do we get married?

2 PRINCE FREDDY

Oh, boy. Hold on! Stop! First you have to answer a question.

3 BRUNHILDA

Yes, I will. I do!

2 PRINCE FREDDY

No. Answer me this.

Take Scene

DROP ALL BUT 2 AND 3
TAKE SCENE AFTER
FREDDY LINE

(He sings.)

### THE ESSENCE OF TRUE BEAUTY LIES



(Tries to answer)

Uh, let me see, true beauty lies in whoever wears these shoes, right? Is that it? If the shoe fits, marry her?

(There is a flash of light and magical sounds.

GWENDOLYN appears.)

GWENDOLYN

Stop!

-20

BRUNHILDA

Who's that?

**GWENDOLYN** 

(Annoyed)

Gwendolyn the Well Wisher!

(BRUNHILDA snuggles up to PRINCE FREDDY.)

3 BRUNHILDA

Well, wish us well!

**GWENDOLYN** 

Ask your question again, Freddy.

PRINCE FREDDY

(Sings)

THE ESSENCE OF TRUE BEAUTY LIES

(GWENDOLYN waves her arms magically and magical sounds are heard.

CINDERELLA can be heard responding.)

CINDERELLA'S VOICE (From off)

(Sings)

BEYOND WHAT'S SEEN BY NORMAL EYES



That's her! I found her!

(GWENDOLYN waves her arms again.)

4 GWENDOLYN

Animal friends? Be not ashamed to be seen! Stand tall!

(There is another flash of light and more magical sounds.

The ANIMAL friends "come to life" again.)

5 CROW / ARISTOTLE

At your humble service!

5 SPIDER / SOCRATES

Ready to lend a hand. Or eight.

5 TOAD / PLATO

A slimy toad and proud of it!

4 GWENDOLYN

Escort Cinderella to us!

(The ANIMAL FRIENDS rush into the house.)

6 PRISCILLA

Was that a toad?

6 CLARISSA

That was the biggest spider I've ever seen.

(CINDERELLA comes out with her ANIMAL FRIENDS.

They help her walk since she can't see well.)

1 CINDERELLA

-10 Freddy?

(PRINCE FREDDY pulls her glasses out of his pocket.)

He steps toward CINDERELLA.)

-22.5

2 PRINCE FREDDY

Would these happen to be your glasses?

(As he tries to hand the glasses to her, BRUNHILDA grabs them.)

-22.5

Oh, let me help with that.

(She "accidentally drops them and steps on them.)

Oh, no! They're broken! Now we'll never know if those were Cinderella's glasses.

6 CLARISSA AND PRISCILLA

Awww!

2 PRINCE FREDDY

That's not a problem.

(He steps toward CINDERELLA.

He takes off his own glasses and puts them on her.

GASTON hands him another set and he puts them on.

They can both see clearly with the big glasses on.)

-15

CINDERELLA

You're the most handsome prince I could imagine.

PRINCE FREDDY

And you're even more beautiful than I remember.

(CINDERELLA and PRINCE FREDDY sing to each other.)

Look at you all grown up, son. I just wish your mother was still alive to see

this. She'd be so proud.



Oh, a widower, are you?

(She sidles up to him.)

Hello there, I'm Cindy's sweet, generous stepmother. But alas, I'm a destitute widow struggling to support three humble daughters.

2 PRINCE FREDDY

Well, we can help them out, can't we Dad?

7 KING FREDERICK

Well, cash flow is a little tight . . .

2 PRINCE FREDDY

What about all those extra rooms at the palace?

**7** KING FREDERICK

Extra rooms?

2 PRINCE FREDDY

You and your family are welcome to stay at the palace!

7 KING FREDERICK

You'll have to earn your keep.

6 PRISCILLA

I can be the palace party planner!

6 CLARISSA

I could be the royal fashion carburetor.

(They "high five" each other.)

3 BRUNHILDA

You know, King Frederick, or can I call you King Freddy, we ought to have dinner sometime soon, like maybe tonight.

**7** KING FREDERICK

Oh-

2 PRINCE FREDDY

Take your time, Dad. Be a king with a heart.

Learn to woo.

(CLARISSA and PRISCILLA snuggle up to him.)

6 CLARISSA AND PRISCILLA

Woo-hoo-hoo.

(GASTON smiles and puts his arms around them.)

**7** KING FREDERICK

All right.

(Taking a second, favorable look at BRUNHILDA.) All right . . .

PRINCE FREDDY

Everybody join us tonight for dinner!

(To the ANIMAL FRIENDS.)

Spiders, crows, toads and all animals included!

5 ALL ANIMALS

Proposal accepted!

(To GWENDOLYN)

Thank you for making my wishes come true.

GWENDOLYN
With a generous heart and an inquisitive mind they always do.
